## SUBSIDY PROGRAM

At Queen's Academy, we believe financial barriers should never limit a child's access to the arts, so our programs are priced below comparable offerings and supported by a limited Subsidy Program that provides reduced-fee spots. ## ATTENDANCE

If your child is not at school on the day of our program, you are required to notify Queen's Academy of your child's absence by email ([queensacademy@hotmail.com](mailto:queensacademy@hotmail.com)) by 1pm each class.

## AFTER SCHOOL

At dismissal students go from their classroom to the afterschool program room (Portable 1) on their own. We offer a 'soft start' at 2:45pm for French students and 3:00pm for English students.

## PICK-UP

At 5:00pm guardians must sign out their child. Students are dismissed to their adults at the Portable 2 doors. Notify Queen's Academy in advance if alternate pick-up/going home arrangements are to be made.

## SHOW

Caregivers are invited to watch our Musical Performance on the last day of each term @5:00pm. Show is inside Portable 2. Two audience members per student. Show length is 10 minutes.

## SNACK

Your child must have an extra after school snack.
