# Musical Theatre Camp – Details

## DROP OFF / PICK UP

Drop off is between 8:45-9:00AM each morning and pick up is 5:00pm. Please notify us in advance if alternate pick-up/going home arrangements are to be made, or if you need to drop off/pick up your child early.

## PARKING

**Halpern Centre SFU** - Park in front of the Diamond Alumni Centre at drop-off/pick-up. We worked with SFU on a solution to alleviate parking fees for drop-offs during our camps. SFU parking are going to suspend ticketing in front of the DAC (Diamond Alumni Centre) from 8:45-9:15am and then again from 4:45-5:15pm everyday Queen's Academy has a camp at the Halpern Centre. For driving directions, put in Diamond Alumni Centre and it will take you to the correct spot to park - which is on the right side of the street in front of DAC. Then you can walk your child across the street and up the ramp to the Halpern Centre. See a SFU map on page 6.
