ATTENDANCE

If your child is not at school on the day of our program, you are required to notify Queen's Academy of your child's absence by email/phone before 1pm each class.

AFTER SCHOOL

At dismissal all students will go from their classroom to the afterschool program room on their own or with assistance from the school.

PICK-UP

At 5:00PM we will bring students out and caregivers will meet their child at the front entrance of the school. Please notify Queen's Academy in advance if alternate pick-up/going home arrangements are to be made.

SHOW

At the end of the term caregivers are invited to watch our show at 5:00pm. Performance takes place inside the inside the music room. Two audience members per student. Show length is 10-15 minutes.

SNACK

Windsor school will provide students with an afterschool snack every class. It is encouraged that your child has their own additional after school snack as well.
