AFTER SCHOOL

At dismissal students grade 1-4 will go from their classroom to the afterschool program room on their own. We offer kindergarten pick-up directly from the classroom at 3:00pm.

PICK-UP

At 5:00pm guardians must sign out their child. Students are dismissed to their adults at the community entrance doors. Notify Queen's Academy in advance if alternate pick-up/going home arrangements are to be made.

Caregivers are invited to watch our Musical Performance on the last day of each term @5:00pm. Show is inside the library. Two audience members per student. Show length is 10 minutes.
